Windows 10 will send data to Microsoft if that feature is enabled in your PC settings. To see this feature in operation you can monitor it using Task Manager.

To launch Task Manager hold down (at the same time) the (Ctrl) (Alt) and (Delete) keys. Click or tap "Task Manager".
