

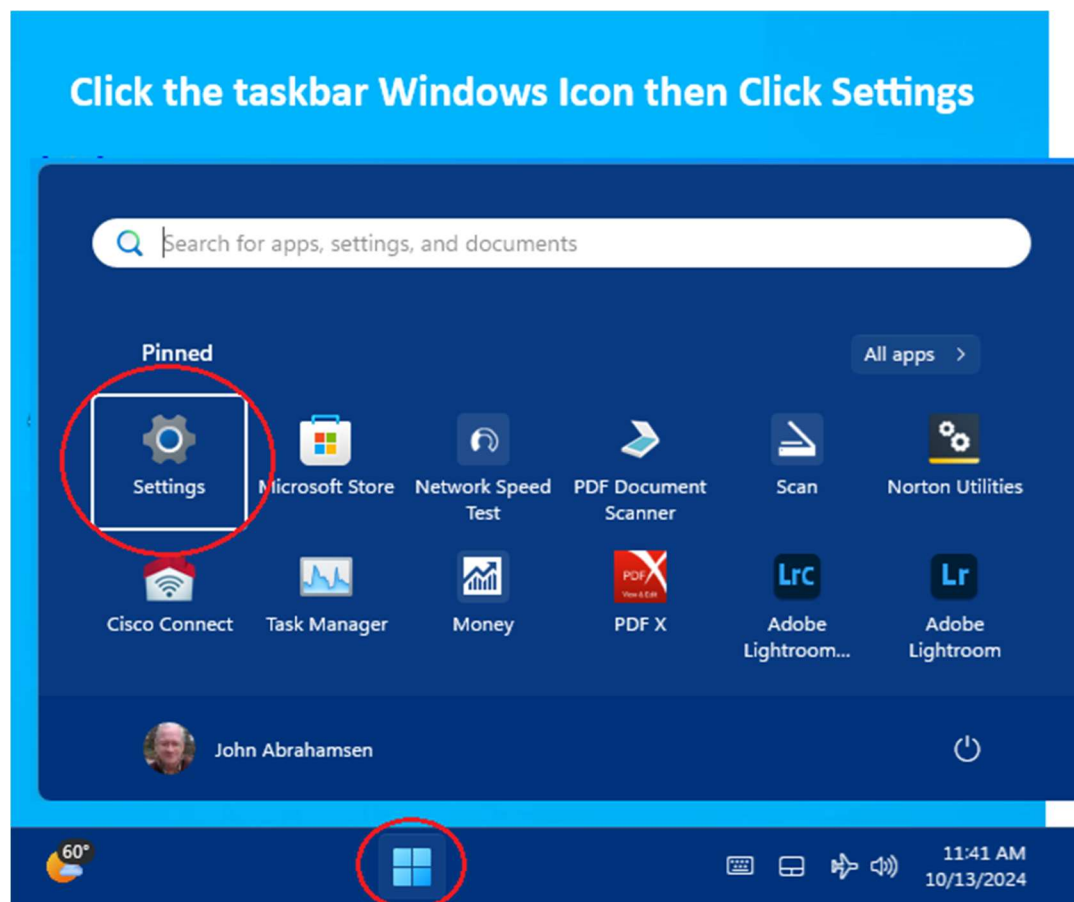
What are widgets?

Widgets are small cards that display dynamic content from your favorite apps and services on your **Windows 11** desktop. They appear on the widgets board, where you can discover, pin, unpin, arrange, resize, and customize widgets to reflect your interests. Your widgets board is optimized to show relevant widgets and personalized content based on your usage.

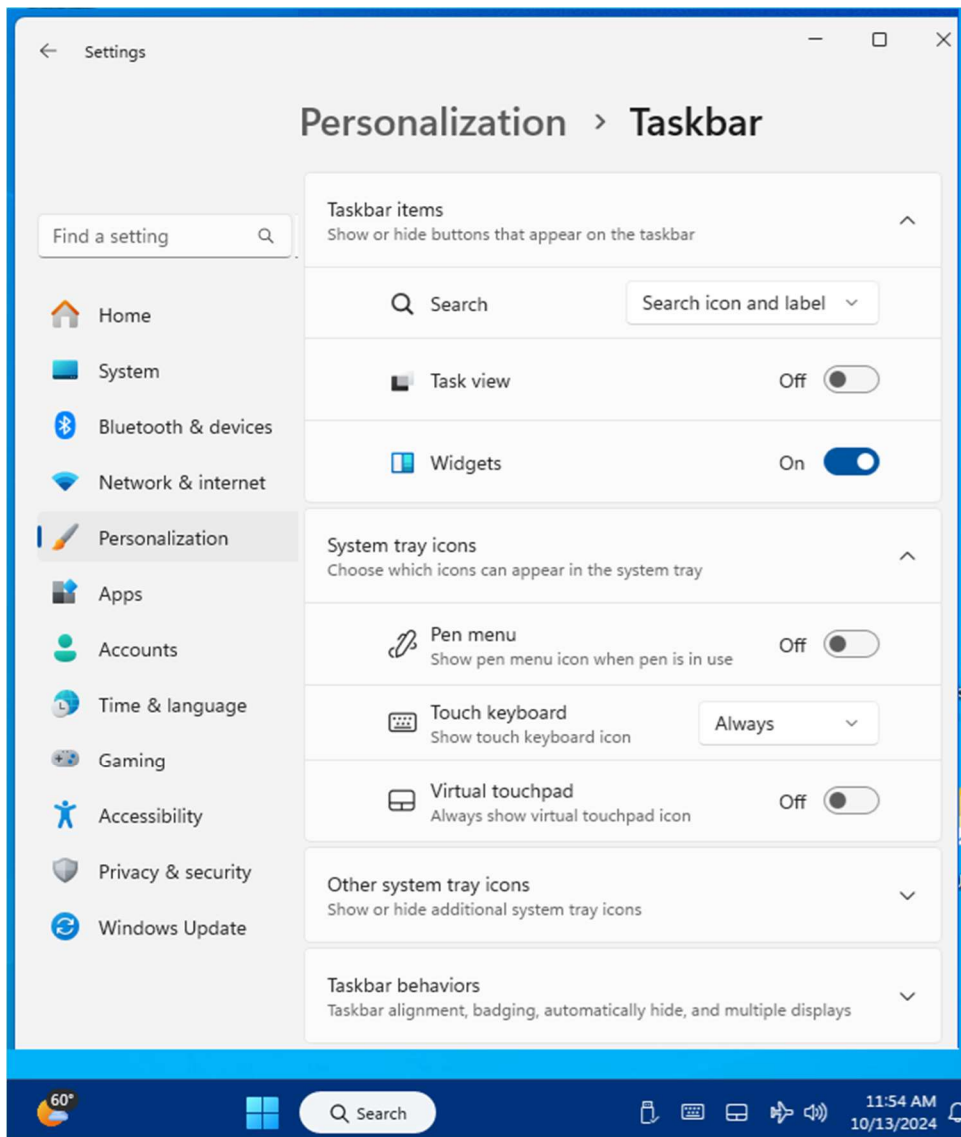
Open the widgets board from the left corner of your taskbar where you see the live weather icon. Widgets help you stay on top of what's important to you by bringing together personalized content from your favorite apps and services so you can have the latest info briefly throughout your day. Say goodbye to constantly switching between apps, devices and websites—now you can stay connected to the things you care about without losing focus on your most important tasks.

Make sure that the Widgets function is turned on.

Go to Settings



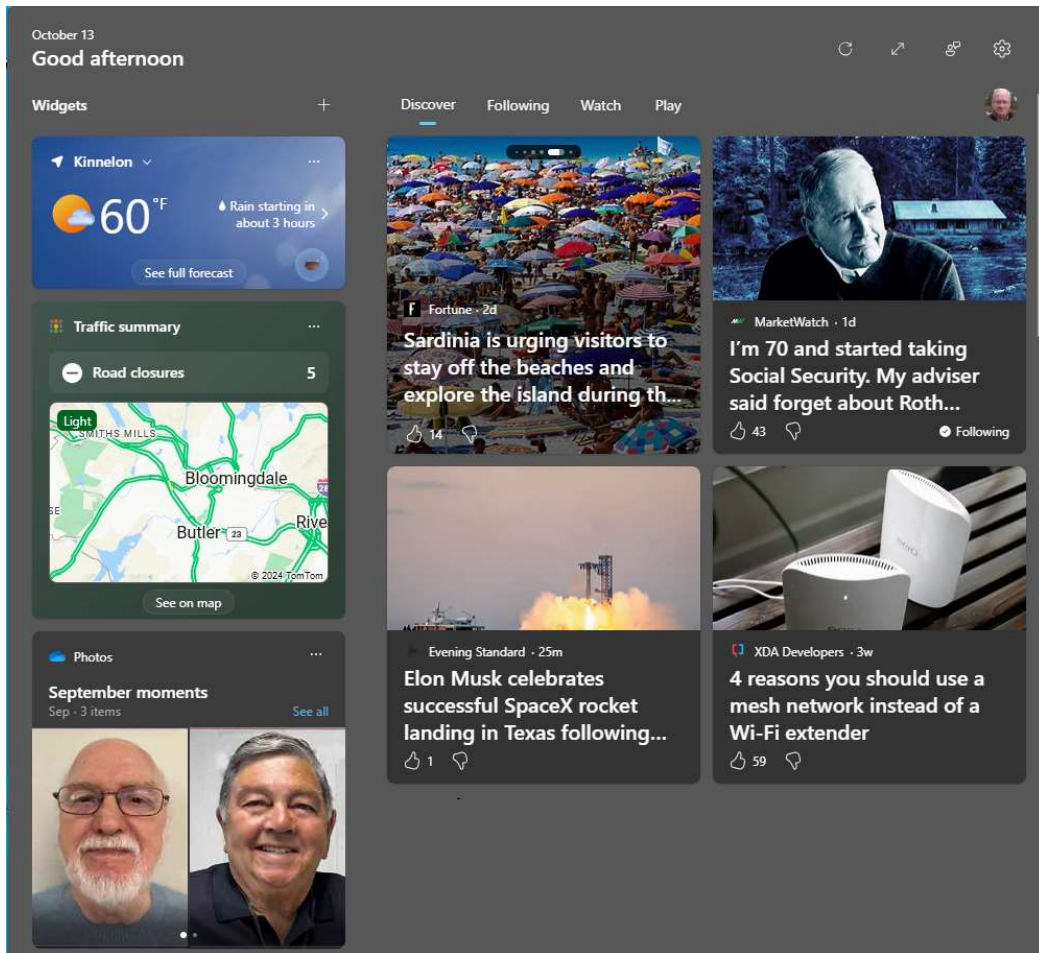
Widgets should be **ON**



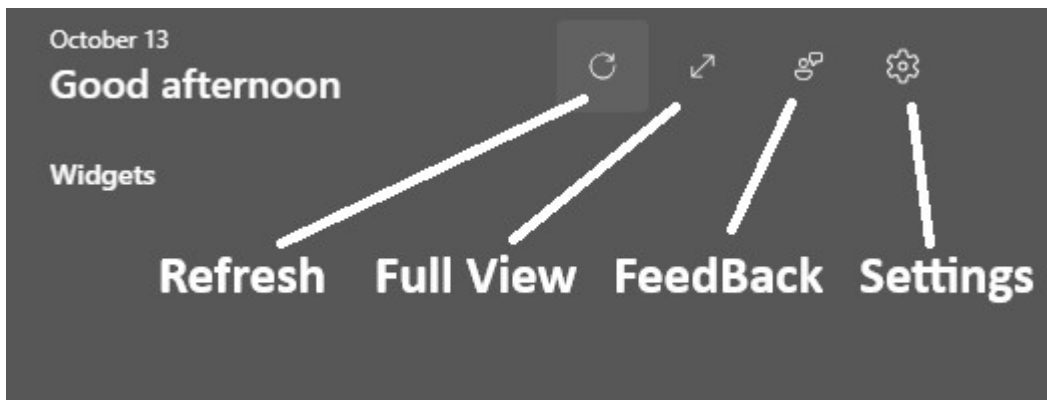
The widgets icon shows a weather image and temperature.



Click or Tap opens the Widgets Board.



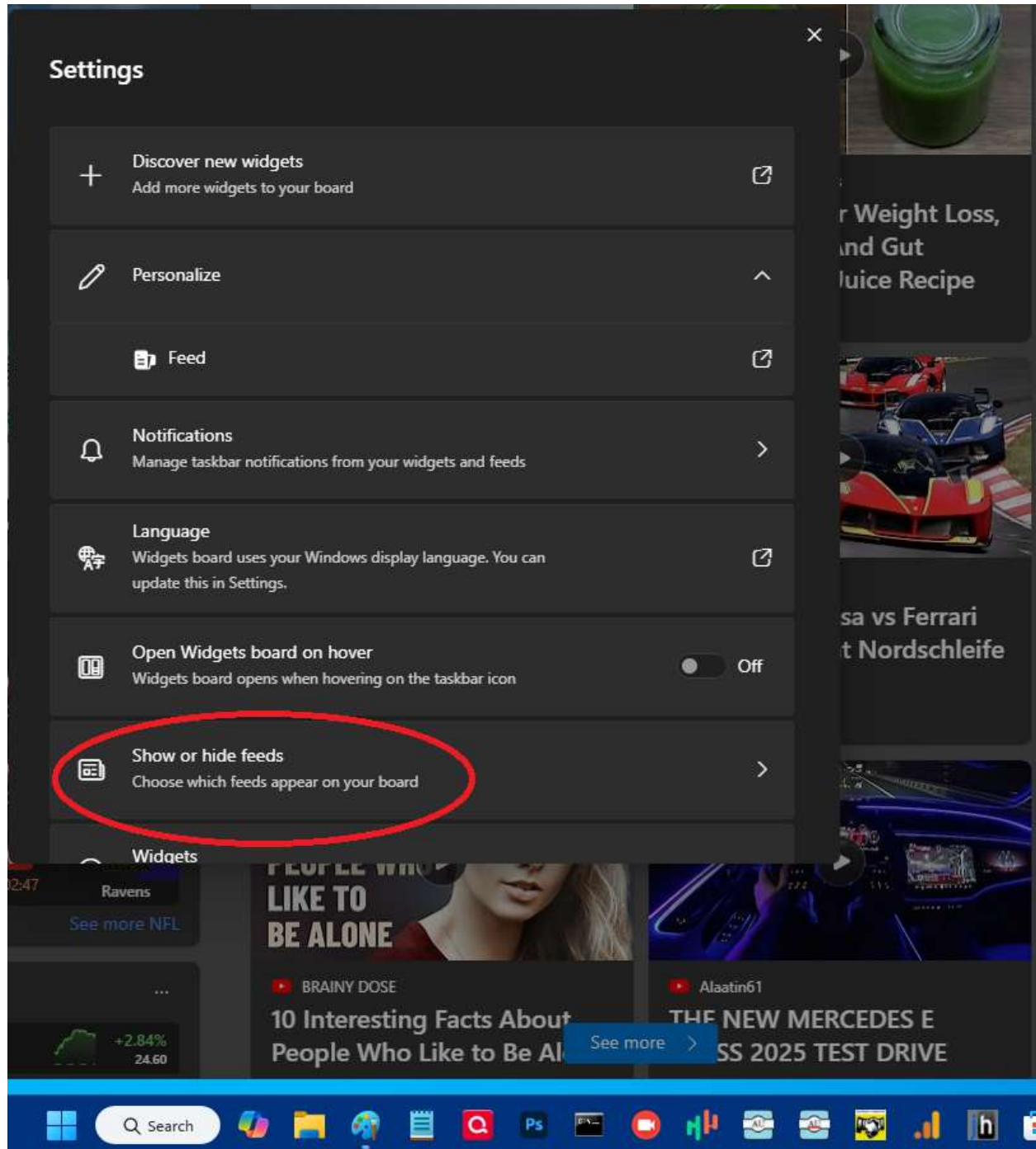
Controls on upper right corner of window



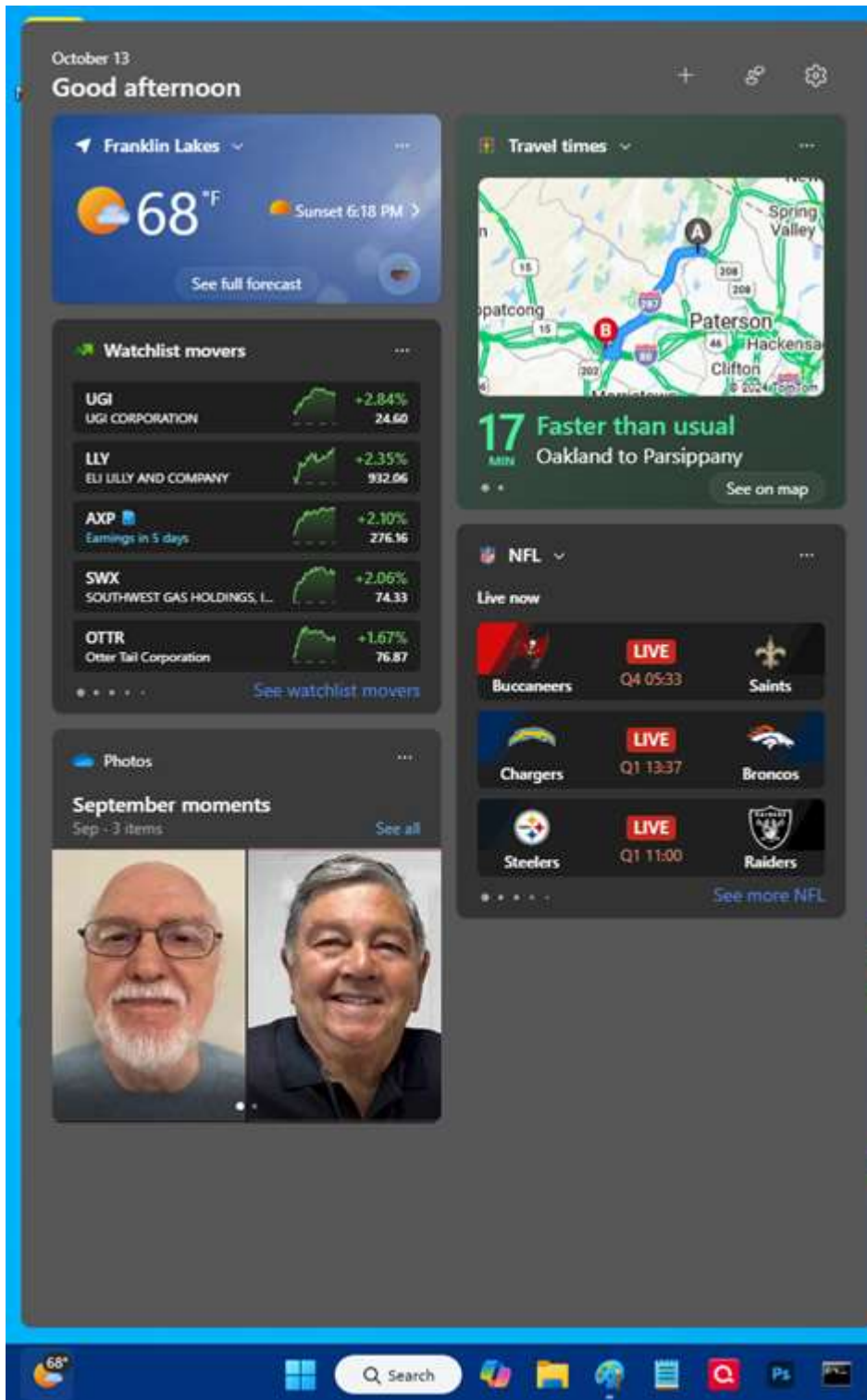
Using Widgets only by turning off Feeds (websites in the right panel)

Go to settings and click “Show or Hide feeds”

Then click the turn on/off toggle switch

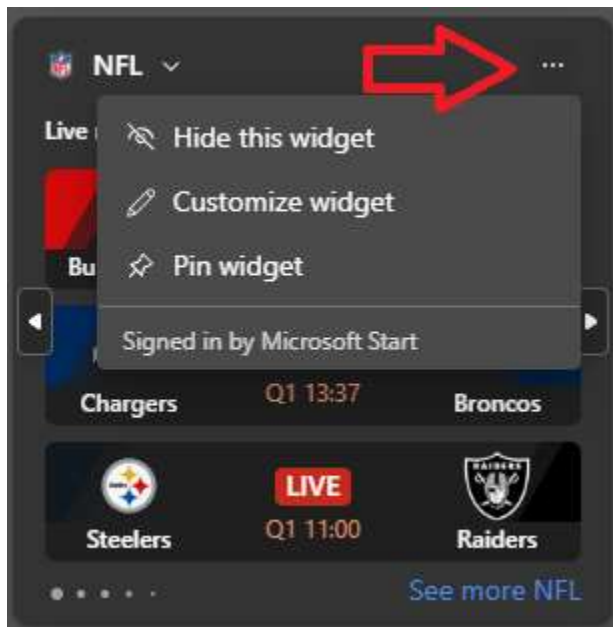


Widgets board with FEED turned off



Widget Controls

Click the 3 dots on top right of widget box to get menu.

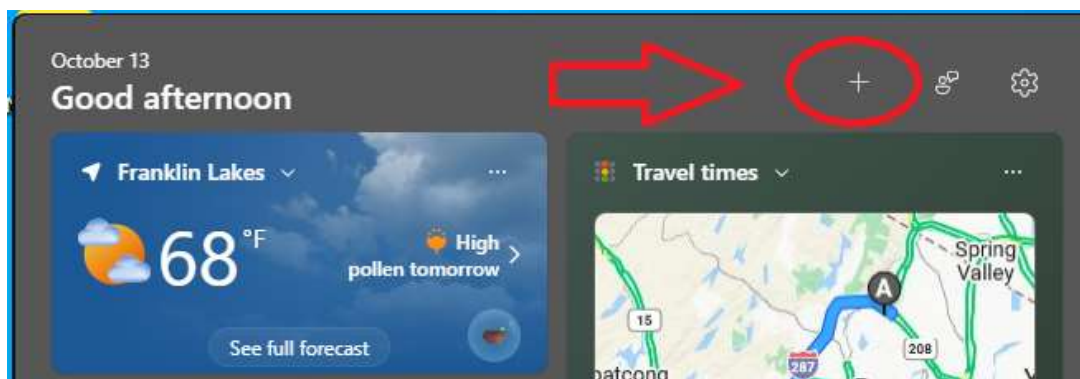


Click “Hide this widget” to stop showing it on the board.

Click “Customize widget” to alter action. In this example a list of NFL teams appears to allow you to select which teams to show.

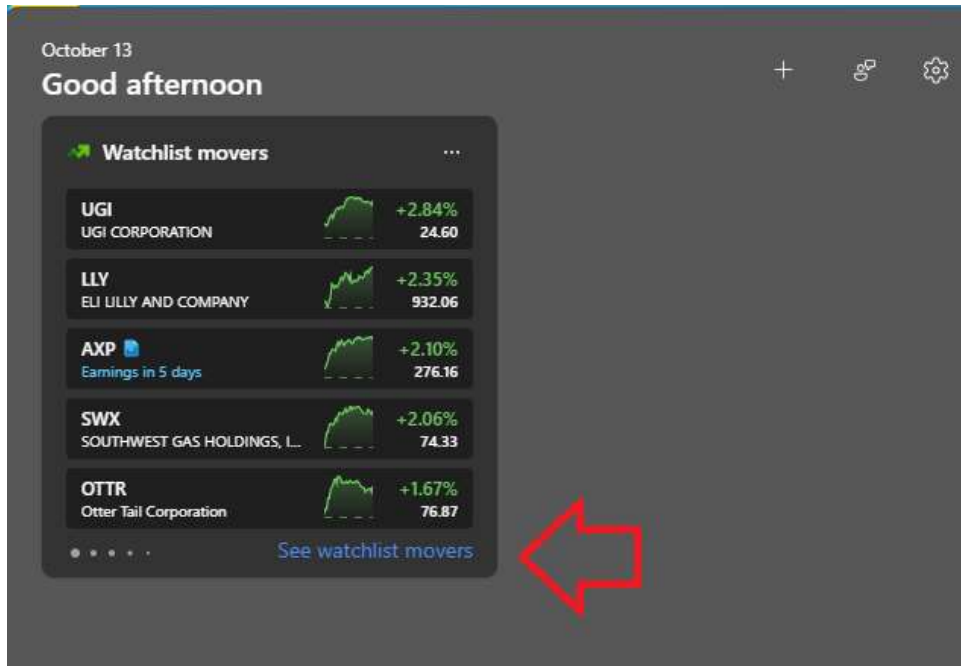
Click “Pin widget” to put it in first position on the widget board. Once pinned using the 3 dots you will see a Unpin widget menu item.

To ADD widgets to the board click on the + found at the top of the board.

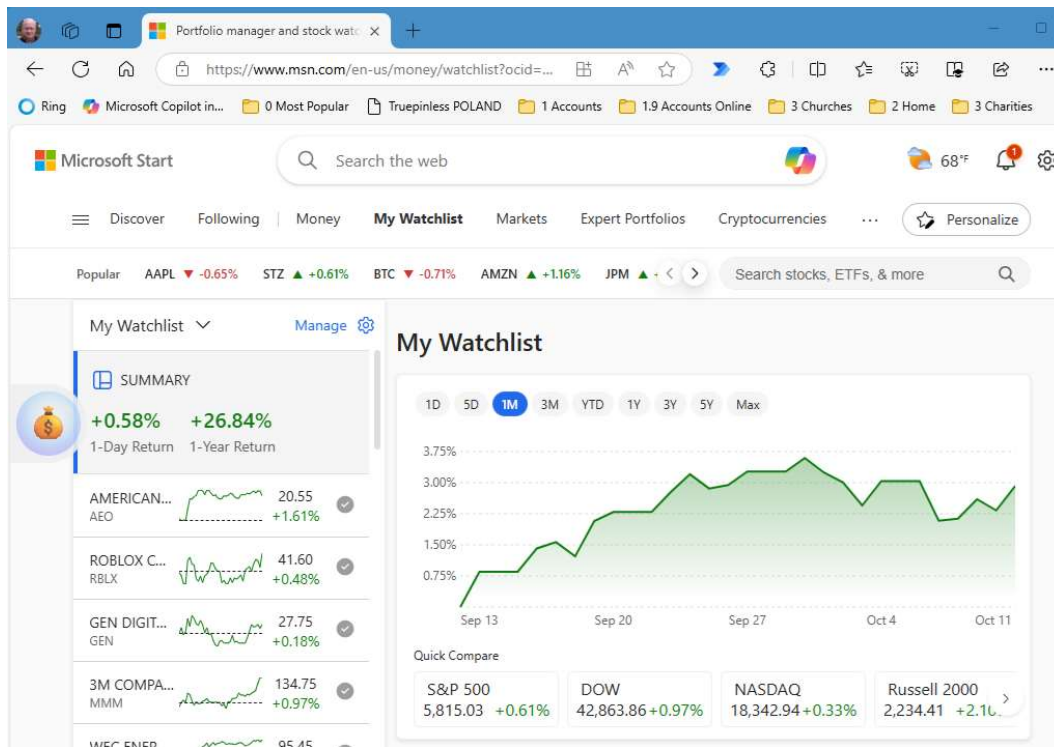


Some Widgets can link to useful applications. The watchlist movers widget will open a money app that allows you to maintain a list of stocks and show data about those stocks.

Click “See watchlist movers” to open the Money APP.
