- 1) Your Partner opens 1H, you say 2H – How many pts do you have? How many hearts?
- 2) Your Partner opens 1H, you say 3H – What do you have?
- 3) Your Partner opens 1N, your opponent says 2D, you Double – What does that mean?
- 4) Your Partner opens 2S – How many Spades does he have? What is his point range?
- 5) Your Partner opens 2S, you say 2NT – What does that mean?
- 6) How many pts do you need to respond to you P's 1NT?
- 7) Your P opens 1C, your opponent says 1H, you Double – What do you have? And, what is this bid called?
- 8) How many pts do you need to go to the 2 level?
- 9) Must you accept a Transfer?
- 10) How do you transfer to a minor?

- 11) If your P changes suits is that forcing?
- 12) How many pts do you need to open in 3rd seat?
- 13) How many pts do you need to open in 4th seat?
- 14) How do you respond to your P's 2C opener?
- 15) How many cards in a suit do you need for an
overall?
- 16) Must you respond to P's double at 1 or 2 level?
- 17) If P opens 1C or 1D – what is he looking for?
- 18) When the dummy is on your left – do you play to his
weakness, or his strength?
- 19) When the dummy is on your right – do you play to
his weakness, or his strength?
- 20) When you Double your opponent's 1H opener –
what is your distribution, and minimum pt count?

Basic Bridge Rules:

- 1) Hold your hand up, so no one else sees it.
- 2) Before play starts, make sure you & your P agree how you will play
- 3) Never lie to your Partner
