

Here's what happened after the last Bridge lesson on 10/4/2017:

- 1) Someone bid 2C and his Partner passed. YOU CAN'T PASS.
- 2) Someone bid 2C and his Partner having 10 points bid 2D which means he has less than 7 points, so that was a bad bid.
- 3) Some opened 2NT, and his Partner having 5 points, passed. When you know you have 25 points you must be in game.
- 4) Someone doubled a 1S opener and his Partner bid 1NT. Bad bid.
- 5) Someone opened 2NT, and his Partner with 5 points, bid 3NT. The opener then bid 4H and made 5. Good contract, but I believe the bidding was wrong.
- 6) Someone bid 2H without have 2 of the top 3 honors, or 3 of the top 5 honors.....that will get you in trouble
- 7) Someone bid 2D, and his Partner bid 3NT with 15 point and 2 D's
- 8) Opener bid 1S, his Partner with 14 points and 4 S's bid 4S. Bad bid
- 9) Someone bid 1C, his Partner 1H, opener bid 1S, responder bid 2D, opener passed. He changed suit wanting another bid. Can't PASS
- 10) Players need to remember that when the DUMMY is on your left, you should play to his strength, when the DUMMY is on your right you should play to his weakness.
