

## Bidding Basics (DO NOT LIE TO YOUR PARTNER)

- 1) If your partner opens, and you have 6 Pts, what do you say? You must bid
- 2) If your partner opens, and you have 10 Pts, what do you say?
- 3) If you go to the 2 level, how many pts must you have? You must have at least 10 pts
- 4) If your partner opens 2C, how do you respond? You must respond
- 5) If you partner changes suits, is that forcing? *Yes*
- 6) If you partner opens a preempt, how many pts do you need to respond? At least 16 pts
- 7) If your partner opens 3NT, how do you respond?
- 8) Do you play 1C forcing, or the better minor, or 4 card diamond suit?
- 9) If you open 1 of a major, don't repeat it w/o having 6
- 10) Must you accept a transfer? *Yes*
- 11) Must you respond to a Double at the 1 or 2 level? *Yes*
- 12) Your P bid 1H, you bid 3H, says you have 10-12 & 4H
- 13) How many cards must you have for an overcall? 5
- 14) How many pts are needed to open in the 3<sup>rd</sup> seat? 11
- 15) How many are needed to open in the 4th seat? 13

How would you respond to your Partner's bid of 1NT?

| 5) 9 points, 4S, 4H, 2D, 3C     | 2C  |
| 6) 10-13 points, 3S, 2H, 3D, 5C | 3NT |
| 7) 10-13 points, 3S, 4H, 3D, 3C | 2C  |
