Transfers

In response to 1 NT, a bid of 2D transfers to Hearts, 2H transfers to Spades (must have at 5-card suit to transfer to majors).

If playing transfers to minors, you must have a 6-card suit. Here, you bid 2S to transfer to clubs; 3C to transfer to D

Stolen Bid Double

Your partner opens 1NT, opponent bids 2C, 2D, 2H, or 2S; that's what you wanted to bid, so you Double, telling your Partner he stole my bid.

What happens after partner completes your transfer?

With 0 – 7 points, you PASS

With 8 – 9 points you bid 2NT and let your partner decide

With 10+ points you bid 3NT

With 16 + points you can 4NT asking for aces

Texas Transfers

After 1NT opener, bid 4D's to transfer to hearts, or 4H 's to transfer to spades. You must have a 6-card suit and at least 8 points. Your partner accepts the transfer, and you PASS.

This works best when there is an intervening bid.
