

Wawayanda State Park - Pinwheel's Vista Hewitt, NJ

This 9 mile (R/T) hike is Moderate to Strenuous. There is a few steep ascents and descents, but it's mostly on level ground. From the Wawayanda Park headquarters, take the .3 mile blue-blazed trail, which leads to the AT. Go left and follow the white-blazed AT, south to the Wawayanda Shelter and continue hiking along the AT. The steel bridge over a stream is 1.1 miles from the shelter side trail. Continue two miles after the bridge, hiking alongside the stream, crossing over another stream near a waterfall. Continue .5 mile crossing a stone wall and onto the junction with the blue-blazed Wawayanda Ridge Trail at mile 4.3. Continue on the AT approx .1 mile to a second blue-blazed trail that takes you to the right for 0.1 mile to Pinwheel's Vista. To return, hike back on the A.T. and pick up the blue-blazed trail to the Wawayanda State Park headquarters
