NOTE FROM THE PRESIDENT

S ummer is upon us and we can now enjoy the outdoors and just in time. We have had a spike in covid infections and while most of us have been vaccinated we are still susceptible as evidenced by my personal experience of May 13 when I got my second booster and then on the 15th was diagnosed with Covid. The positive note is that the symptoms are like an old fashioned cold but with the inconvenience of quarantine. Lesson learned by me so enjoy being outside as much as possible both at restaurants and other activities but use caution in crowded areas.

We had a terrific turnout for the **Spring luncheon** with 126 participating. In addition, the 50/50 raffle generated \$300 shared among three winners.

The Board was asked to consider **additional insurance** for AU drivers who were carpooling to/from AU sponsored events. We were able to add an additional \$1 million of liability coverage *on top of* whatever the coverage that the AU driver has. The AU driver's insurance remains the primary and is first in the event of an accident. This coverage should be considered an additional layer of protection and is incidental. The prorated cost of the coverage for 2022 is nominal and we have secured the rider on our policy.

The objective of the increased coverage was to encourage car pooling to not only club meetings but to certain of the Trips and Tours events where a bus is no longer economically feasible. For example, those who did not feel comfortable driving to Morristown for the **Dion concert** on July 21 can possibly catch a ride with another member. This same applies to the golfers driving to the **Farmstead Golf outing** of June 29th and other events and meetings. Let's open our doors to those who are not able to drive or do not feel safe driving at night. Our clubs offer interesting opportunities to enjoy your favorite activities.

Scam information for those who use Amazon
