O ur speaker for the AU General meeting on March 9, 2021 will be William "Pat" Schuber. Pat has served in a number of positions over the years including, but certainly not limited to, County Executive for Bergen County (12 years), NJ State Assembly (9 years) as Asst. Minority Leader, Mayor of the Borough of Bogota (4 years) as well as Borough Council (8 years) and Commissioner of the Port Authority of NY (6 years). He is a Clinical Professor at the School of Public and Global Affairs at Fairleigh Dickenson University and has held several other academic positions. He has lectured frequently on history, historical leadership, homeland security, ethics, communication and conflict resolution.

He will be speaking to us on the Irish experience in the Great War. As the beginning of the Great War (WWI) loomed over Europe, the British Parliament debated a Home Rule law for Ireland, a long-sought goal of the Irish leaders. As WWI began this legislation was postponed and an implicit promise was made to take it up after the war ended with the understanding that Ireland would aid in the war effort. This is the story of those men who fought in WWI and the social and political outcome of the actions taken after the war.

The AU Stock Market Club provides a forum for both novice and seasoned investors to share investment ideas and to participate in the stock market for fun and profit. We presently have 23 members, some with little or no investment experience, who meet twice monthly, currently via a Zoom meeting. Market conditions are discussed as well as individual stocks for trading. While 2020 was not a good year in many respects, it was a good year for our investments. With a stock portfolio of approximately \$190,000 we earned \$2,300 in dividends and \$58,700 in capital gains. Our Net Asset value in 2020 increased by 22.1%, besting the S&P by 5.9%
