
Covid 19 protocols when attending AU functions.

NOMINATIONS FOR THE EXECUTIVE BOARD 2022

Extract from AU By-laws:

Officers shall serve one term in the office to which they have been elected. However, at the option of the then member in office and the Nominating Committee, the Treasurer, Assistant Treasurer and Secretary may be elected for a second consecutive term. Except as otherwise provided herein, a member may again be elected to the same office provided that at least one term has elapsed. This does not restrict members from being elected to a different office in the interim.

Installation of newly elected officers shall be the final "Order of Business" at the Annual Meeting, which will take place at the November General Meeting.

Note: It has often been the past practice that the 1st VP, the 2nd VP, and Asst. Treasurer, step up to the next position. Also, the past Presidents need to confirm their desire to continue to serve. However, it is up to the Nominating Committee to finally decide the slate to be put forward to the Membership at the October General Meeting. All Members are also free to put forward nominations should they desire at that Meeting.

The nominations shall be closed at the November General meeting. The election of the new officers by voice vote shall proceed. However, if there is more than one nominee for a particular office, voting shall be done by ballot.
