February 09, 2021

- Call to order by President Mark Cohen at 1:05 p.m.
- Pledge of Allegiance was led by Dick Hench.
- Reverend Andy Kadzban gave the Invocation.
- Treasurer's report – Jeff Mohn reported that AU has \$24,000 in the bank. Currently 266 members have paid their 2021 dues and 46 members have yet to pay. Jeff will distribute a list of names to be called by board members to determine if they will pay the 2021 dues.
- President Cohen wished that all members were well and that people are getting the Covid19 vaccinations. He reported that we are trying to plan a physical event as soon as possible. He talked about the testing of a hybrid meeting, where a physical meeting would be combined with a Zoom session.
